**TENANTS ANNOUNCED FOR SUMNER COUNTY'S
NEWEST LIFESTYLE CENTER**

HENDERSONVILLE (Nashville), Tennessee – January 2, 2007... Columbus, Ohio-based Continental Retail Development (CRD) and Nashville-based HALO Properties, LLC announced today the first group of tenants for Indian Lake Village and The Streets of Indian Lake, the retail component of the project. CRD President David Kass made the announcement.

In addition to the retailers, Seattle-based R.W. Beck Inc. - an international engineering firm - will relocate its Tennessee office from Goodlettsville to the project to occupy 16,000 square feet in the first of several Chenault Farms Class A office buildings with a projected 2,500,000 square feet of space.

"We are thrilled to be bringing these great specialty retail and entertainment tenants to Hendersonville," said Kass. "This is just the first wave. We will have many more great names to share with you in the weeks and months ahead."

Halo's managing partner, Danny Hale, echoed Kass' sentiment by adding, "this is only the beginning of the next major growth surge in the Middle Tennessee area". "When you combine the current housing population in the Hendersonville/Gallatin area - with the additional 15,000 homes slated for construction nearby - Indian Lake Village becomes an almost required presence for growth-minded businesses."

The Streets of Indian Lake is 405,000 square foot lifestyle center located at the intersection of Vietnam Veterans Blvd. and Indian Lake Blvd in Hendersonville, Tennessee. The project, which breaks ground this month and is scheduled to open in March, 2008, is a component of a large mixed-use master plan currently under development by HALO, Indian Lake Village. The Indian Lake Village plan includes Chenault Farms, an office park with more than one million square feet, in addition to a retail power center and upscale multifamily housing.
